MINUTES OF THE ONLINE MEETING OF CORBRIDGE PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON 28 OCTOBER 2020

PRESENT Councillor W Clouston, Chair of the Council together with Councillors: Mrs E S Buckley, C G Curry, N M Oliver, M F Griffin, S Ahmed, L Rogers and M J Stone.

1020.01 RESIDENTS

- a) Milkwell Development. It was noted that a gateway had been created in the hedge between Corbridge Middle School and the Riggs. Concerns were expressed that The Riggs could become a drop off/pick up point. Cllr N M Oliver will speak to the School and pass on the concerns. Any reports of this should be reported to Cllr N M Oliver in the first instance.
- **1020.02 APOLOGIES.** Apologies received and accepted from Cllr Mrs M V Kemp.
- **1020.03 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.** Cllr N M Oliver declared a personal and prejudicial interest in item 1020.08 as a member of Northumberland County Council Planning Committees.
- **1020.04 MINUTES.** It was proposed by Cllr M J Stone, seconded by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, and AGREED to accept and approve the minutes of the meeting held on 23 September 2020.
- **1020.05 ACTIONS ARISING FOLLOWING THE MEETING HELD ON 23 SEPTEMBER 2020.** All actions are covered within the agenda.

1020.06 FINANCE/ADMINISTRATION

- a) **Accounts for payment.** It was proposed by Cllr M J Stone, seconded by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, and AGREED to approve the items of expenditure on the list, previously circulated (Appendix A).
- b) **Budget Report and Bank Reconciliation**. It was proposed by Cllr M J Stone, seconded by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, and AGREED to accept and approve the Budget Report and Bank Reconciliation for the period up to 30 September 2020.
- c) To consider request for Grant Aid from Corbridge Cricket Club. It was proposed by Cllr M J Stone, seconded by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, and AGREED to contribute £250 to the Cricket Club for their electronic scoreboard project. Cllr N M Oliver had given a £2000 contribution from his Small Member Scheme.
- d) To consider request for Grant Aid from the Great North Air Ambulance. It was proposed by Cllr M J Stone, seconded by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, and AGREED to give a £250.00 contribution.
- **1020.07 PLANNING DECISIONS**. It was proposed by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, seconded by Cllr M J Stone, and AGREED that the Council receive the details of the Planning Decisions made by Northumberland County Council, in accordance with the list circulated. (APPENDIX A)
- **1020.08 PLANNING APPLICATIONS.** It was proposed by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, seconded by Cllr M J Stone and AGREED to accept the decisions of the Planning Advisory Group in accordance with the list circulated. (APPENDIX B)
- **1020.09 CORRESPONDENCE.** Correspondence and information items received since the September meeting had been listed on the agenda and were noted. APPENDIX D. Most items had already been circulated to all Councillors by email.
 - a) Corbridge Heritage Trails. It was noted that Corbridge Heritage Trails is to dissolve the Charity on 31 December 2020. Two trails, the Historic Corbridge Trail and Historic Fortifications Trail were completed in 2012 and a small amount of NCC by NCC remains to complete the Historic Dilston Trail. The Parish Council expressed their thanks to Corbridge Heritage Trails and in particular David Waugh who have worked tirelessly to create the 3 Historic Walks around Corbridge.

1020.10 TO RECEIVE REPORTS FROM WORKING/LIAISON GROUPS AND UPDATE FROM CHAIRMAN AND COUNTY COUNCILLOR

01. Chairman's Report.

Neighbourhood Plan. A meeting is to be held on 29 October with Jenny Ludman the Planning Consultant to discuss how to approach the Neighbourhood Plan. It is expected the Neighbourhood Plan can be created using a slimmed down, more streamline approach. It is important to reach out to key landowners at the beginning of the process. A report will be given at the next meeting. **Corchester Field.** Outline proposals had been submitted to Historic England. These included the refurbishment of the pavilion, replacement of the fence, creation of cycle parking and tree planting. Historic England are supportive of the proposals with the exception of the tree planting. A formal application will need to be made to submitted for Schedule Monument Consent.

Railings. The sandstone plinths are to be delivered next week and arrangement are being made to paint the railings although this is weather dependant. It may be that the railings will not be installed under Spring 2021.

Parish Hall. The photographs of Corbridge are being hung in Parish Hall and this should be completed shortly.

a) To consider fee proposal from Robinson Landscape Design for the design and concept work for Corbridge Market Place. The proposal is to split the work into 2 phases with the cost of the first phase being £4000. The first phase will be a conceptual design in 2D, establishing the kerbs to enable the design to be approved by NCC. This will establish the legal boundaries of what is possible. The second phase will create the detail being mindful of residents and businesses that

- share the space. It was proposed by Cllr Mrs E S Buckley, seconded by Cllr M J Stone, and AGREED to accept the fee proposal from Robinson Landscape Design and move forward with the project.
- b) To consider promoting a wider 20mph limit within Corbridge. The Parish Council had submitted a 20mph limit as one of their priorities in the 2021-22 Local Transport Plan Programme. Although submitted, this will be prioritised with all requests in the County. Cllr N M Oliver advised that the traffic reducing measure studies for Aydon Road and Newcastle Road are still to be carried out. Once the studies have been carried out by NCC, recommendations will be made to the Parish Council with a view to implementing. Speeding on Newcastle Road was discussed, and it was noted the Vehicle Activated Sign is not working. This will be investigated. Cllr M J Stone had been contacted by a resident who has problems crossing Main Street. Various options had been looked into previously by the Parish Council. Cllr M J Stone had monitored traffic over a 2 week period in various locations around Corbridge where the average speeds in all locations were found to be over the speed limit. Cllr N M Oliver gave an update on the Community Speedwatch Scheme which is currently under review. It is hoped this will be reinstated soon. Cllr Oliver had met with Inspector Neill to request speeding enforcement in Corbridge.
- **02.** County Councillor Report. Cllr Oliver gave his verbal report on matters relating to Corbridge and Northumberland County Council.

Highway Matters. The handrail on Appletree Lane is still waiting to be installed. Priory Gardens is currently being resurfaced and should be completed this week.

Reopening of Library. Cllr N M Oliver advised that there was some hesitation by NCC to open the library in Corbridge. A temporary cleaner had been found and can start immediately. Cllr Oliver will continue to pursue this.

Newcastle Road Planning Application. It is expected that a decision will be made on this application soon. If the Planning Officer is minded to approve this application, then this will be sent to Committee to make the final decision.

Climate Change Project. Discussions are taking place with NCC Officers to provide an electric bike scheme from the railway station. It is hoped further information will be available by the next meeting. There is the potential opportunity for a whole of village energy scheme. This would include the Parish Hall, Cemetery Lodge, Milkwell Development Houses, and the Library. It was AGREED to set up a sub-committee to take this forward. Cllr M J Stone will join this committee. Additional councillors would be welcome to join and should contact Cllr Oliver direct.

Covid-19 Response. It was noted that the Covid rates in Northumberland are levelling off. There are 5 cases in Corbridge. On Tuesday, the hospitals in Northumbria were amply resourced with sufficient beds.

Car Park Extension. Nothing to report. Cllr N M Oliver is hoping for an update at the next Parish Council Meeting.

- **03.** To consider planting schedule and locations for the free tree pack suppled by NCC. The tree pack from NCC will be picked up on 3 December 2020. The following areas were suggested to plant the trees; The Chains (behind the play area), Barclays Garden, Wellbank Green and Stanners Wood. Cllr W Clouston is to take advice on the planting of the trees.
- **04.** To consider Cllr M F Griffin's recommendation to withdraw from LA7 to enable Northumberland to be treated separately regarding the new Covid 19 3 Tier Govt restrictions. Cllr N M Oliver advised that NCC is discussing the issue regularly with the leaders of the LA7 and government. It was AGREED this was not a Parish Council matter and the Parish Council would not pursue this recommendation.
- 1020.11 ANY URGENT BUSINESS ALLOWED BY THE CHAIRMAN [FOR INFORMATION PURPOSES ONLY]
 - a) NCC GROUNDWORKS CONTRACT. Cllr M F Griffin requested that the Parish Council obtain the breakdown costs of the contract with NCC. It had been agreed at the last meeting that these would be obtained at the end of the year with a view to putting the grass cutting element of the contract out to tender.
- **1020.12 ITEMS FOR INFORMATION ONLY / ADDITIONAL COMMENTS FROM RESIDENTS.** It was reported that the Vehicle Activated Sign on Stagshaw Road is not working correctly. This will be investigated.
- **1020.13 DATE OF NEXT MEETING.** The next meeting of Corbridge Parish Council will be held on Wednesday 25th November 2020 at 7.00pm. NALC/SLCC advice is for Parish Councils to meet virtually. Should this advice change, meetings will be held in Corbridge Parish Hall.
